

What is the Rule When?

Your ball is near a grumpy kangaroo that does not want to move.



The relevant rule is: **1-4. Points Not Covered by Rules**

*If any point in dispute is not covered by the **Rules**, the decision should be made in accordance with equity.*


Decision 1-4/10: ... it is unreasonable to expect a player to play from a dangerous situation; such as when a rattlesnake or bees interfere with play, and unfair to require the player to incur a penalty

“through the green” - drop, without penalty, at the nearest spot, not nearer the hole that is not dangerous, and that is not on the green, nor in a hazard.

On the green - place the ball, without penalty, at the nearest spot, not nearer the hole, that is not dangerous and that is not in a hazard.

In a hazard (including bunkers) you need to drop in the hazard, or in a similar hazard away from the danger. If this isn't possible, you will be forced to drop under the penalty of one stroke, out of the hazard.

YES - You can use a substitute ball.
